

Team Arrival / Team Packets

- 1) Teams may pick up their packets on Thursday, December 26, after 6:30 p.m. at the Radisson Hotel in the Illinois Room.
- 2) If you do not pick up your team packet on Thursday night, please pick it up at team check-in on Friday morning at the South Hall / Ballroom counter (see #6 below for directions).
- 3) Team packets will include the following:
 - Five (5) entry pass lanyards for coaches / team personnel.
 - Temporary passes for each wrestler entered in the tournament, which will get them into Friday's weigh-in only. Wrestlers will then turn in their temporary pass at the scale and receive their lanyard immediately after they weigh in.
- 4) You may purchase additional passes for extra personnel who HELP you during the event for \$35. These are floor passes, so the price is the same for both adults and students. Please use these admissions for qualified personnel only -- these are not for parents, friends, siblings, etc. to watch or coach from the arena area. Payment for these additional passes can be made by:
 - Credit card. Note that the transaction fee will be charged back to the cardholder.
 - Check made out to "HOLMEN AREA FOUNDATION."
- 5) Entry into the La Crosse Center on Friday and Saturday:
 - Teams should enter on the Second Street side of the La Crosse Center using the South Hall / Ballroom entrance. When facing the building, this entrance is on the left side closest to the Radisson Center (not hotel). Do not use the arena doors.
 - This will be the only entrance for teams including wrestlers, coaches, managers, and cheerleaders.
 - The main entrance will be for general admission and media.
 - The back door on the Front Street side of the La Crosse Center will be for staff and deliveries only. Team entry will not be allowed.
 - The skywalk entrance is for ticket holders and staff only -- no teams. You will be allowed to exit the arena through the skywalk, but re-entry will need to be done through the South Hall / Ballroom entrance.
- 6) The La Crosse Center will not allow coolers or bags in the arena seating area. This is a La Crosse Center policy, and violators will have their items confiscated. Teams must use the arena level to store their gear.
