## Tournament Format

## Brackets

1) The girls will compete in one division using a 32-man bracket.

- Teams will enter one girl per weight class.
- After initial line-ups have been entered, schools will be able to submit additional nonscoring wrestlers to fill the brackets.
- Brackets will be drawn at 10:00 a.m. on December 27.

2) The boys will use a 64-man bracket, with wrestlers competing against other wrestlers in all three divisions.

- Brackets will be drawn at 10:00 a.m. on December 28.

3) Once brackets are finalized, any scratches or weight misses will be marked as forfeits -brackets will not be redrawn.

## Mats

Ten (10) mats will be used for Sessions 1, 2, 3, and 4. Session 5 will use three (3) mats.

## Placement Matches

## Girls

1) Matches for $1^{\text {st }}, 3^{\text {rd }}, 5^{\text {th }}$, and Consolation Championship will be wrestled during Session 3 on mats 1-4.
2) The starting weight class for Finals will be announced at the conclusion of Session 1.

## Boys

1) Matches for $7^{\text {th }}, 9^{\text {th }}$, and $11^{\text {th }}$ place will be wrestled at the end of Session 4.
2) Finals will be wrestled during Session 5 :

- 1st place matches will be wrestled on an elevated stage in the middle.
- 3rd and 5th place matches will be wrestled on the outer mats next to the elevated stage.

3) The starting weight class for Finals will be announced at the conclusion of Session 4.

## Match Lengths

1) Championship matches will be 2-2-2.
2) Wrestleback matches will be 1-2-2.
