The Bi-State Classic is held at the La Crosse Center, a multi-purpose convention center located in the heart of downtown La Crosse, nestled on the banks of the Mississippi River. While it was built in 1980, a major renovation and expansion that started in 2020 nearly doubled the center in size. The Bi-State competition is held in the arena with 21,000 sq. ft. of open floor space and seating up to 8,000 people, depending on the type of event being held.

- The boys will compete in the Main Arena. The girls will compete in South Hall on Day 1 and in the Main Arena on Day 2.
- Separate changing areas will be available for boys and girls in South Hall next to the weigh-in area.
- Wrestlers must supply their own towels, as none will be supplied for the event.
- Full concessions will be available for purchase.
- The La Crosse Center does not allow any bags or coolers in the arena seating areas. Therefore, all wrestlers' bags and coolers will need to remain on the main floor.
- Bags / purses are allowed for spectators, subject to search. However, food and drink are prohibited.
- Reminder -- the La Crosse Center is cleared between sessions. All wrestlers, coaches, and spectators should take their belongings with them and not leave them in the Center.
